

# The investment decision for digitalization change within the procurement organization – practical master thesis

Procurement in the future will look fundamentally different than today. In addition to a changed requirement profile, new complex tasks will fall within the scope of procurement. Other, mostly standardized processes, however, will be digitized.

The thesis will mainly include the following tasks:

- Literature review on future roles of procurement and resources needed
- Exchange with project partners to evaluate requirements and developments in the industry
- Evaluation of resulting requirements
- Development of a calculation model based on the findings
